STUDENT ASSESSMENT/COURSE PLACEMENT

Computer-based placement tests are available at each SWIC campus. Once students have completed the New Student Information Form and received their SWIC Student ID Number, they may go to any SWIC Testing Center and take this test.

Visit swic.edu/students/services/testing-centers for locations and hours. This test identifies skill levels in math, reading and language usage. In the eSTORM Student Center, you can search and register* for classes, apply for Foundation scholarships, check your financial-aid status, print class schedules, see account statements and payment deadlines, make a payment, view grades, apply for graduation, request transcripts and more.

To activate your account, visit estorm.swic.edu and click New User. Activation requires that you have completed online orientation or enrolled in a class. You will also need your student ID number, Social Security number and date of birth.
