

## MacMurray College's Transfer Guide

### For Southwestern Illinois College A.A.S. in Sign Language Studies: Interpreter to B.A. in Interpreter Preparation: American Sign Language and English

Students who transfer to MacMurray with the Associate in Applied Science degree in Sign Language Studies: Interpreter at Southwestern Illinois College will be granted 67 transfer credits (junior standing) at MacMurray.

Courses taken at Southwestern Illinois College will satisfy MacMurray course requirements as indicated below, providing courses are passed with a grade of "C" or better.

#### MacMurray General Education requirements:

These students will have satisfied the following MacMurray general education requirements:

- ❖ MacMurray Rhetoric 101 (with SWIC ENG 101 Rhetoric & Composition I)
- ❖ MacMurray Rhetoric 103 (with SWIC SPCH 151 Fundamentals of Public Speaking)
- ❖ MacMurray Social Science breadth course (with SWIC SOC 153 Introductory Sociology)

These students must still complete the following MacMurray general education requirements, unless they have taken equivalent courses at SWIC:

- ❖ Rhetoric 102 (=SWIC ENG 102 Rhetoric & Composition II)
- ❖ Math 125 (=SWIC MATH 111 plus MATH 112, OR MATH 213)
- ❖ One Natural Science breadth course (with lab: biology, chemistry, physics)
- ❖ One Humanities breadth course (literature, philosophy, religion Spanish)
- ❖ One Fine Arts breadth course (art, music, theatre, creative writing)
- ❖ Two courses in MacMurray's Issues of Community and Conflict sequence (IOCC 201, 301, 401)
- ❖ Cultural Studies 300, Diversity and the American Experience

These students must also pass the Junior-level writing proficiency exam (not a course)

#### MacMurray requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree in Interpreter Preparation

- ❖ ASLA 250 American Sign Language IV (or test out of course): 3 credits
- ❖ ASLA 370 Introduction to the Deaf Community : 3 credits
- ❖ IPPR Interpreting Accommodation and Specialized Interpreting : 3 credits
- ❖ IPPR 475 Practicum : 15 credits
