Basic Arson Investigator Class

Southwestern Illinois Police Academy

The Southwestern Illinois Police Academy will be presenting the 200-hour Basic Arson Investigator Class beginning August 12, 2019.

This is a 5-week course, for fire personnel, is presented over 2 months and includes the 40-hour Mandatory Firearms Certification.

The course will be held at the **New Lenox Fire Protection District**, 261 E. Maple, New Lenox, IL 60451.

Upon successful completion of the course, the attendee may submit for certification to the Office of the State Fire Marshal as an Arson Investigator.

Attendees may pay the tuition fee personally, but must be enrolled by the training officer or other command officer from their agency and meet the following requirements.

To attend this course, enrollees must:

- **Successful completion of Modules I, II and III of the Fire Investigator Course (see Section 141.334).**
- **Employed by a local governmental agency or the Office.**
- **Submit a letter of approval from Fire Chief to attend the course and acknowledging that the attendee will be attending firearms training.**

Certification of an Arson Investigator does not automatically qualify one to carry a firearm. Firearm possession for Arson Investigators is based upon approval of the investigator's fire or police chief or home rule ordinance. For questions regarding this issue, contact your jurisdiction's legal advisor.

Southwestern Illinois Police Academy will verify all enrollee's certifications and employment through the Illinois State Fire Marshal's office prior to the beginning of the course.

Students must be approved by Illinois State Fire Marshal's Office to attend this course.
