Student Video Contest
Contest Description, Official Rules, and Requirements of Entries

OFFICIAL RULES:

1. The contest is open to any student currently registered at SWIC during the Fall 2020 semester.
2. There is a limit of one (1) entry per student.
3. The entry must be no less than 25 seconds and no greater than 45 seconds in length.
4. Entries must follow the Requirements of Entries.
5. An entry must be in a format that is easily viewable on typical electronic devices and easily viewable when posted to social media.
6. By submitting an entry, entrants give express consent for their entry to be posted on SWIC social media sites.
7. Entries will be accepted through Monday, October 26, 2020.
8. The drawing for the two cash prizes will be conducted on Tuesday, October 27, 2020.
9. The contest is subject to all federal, state, and local laws.

REQUIREMENTS OF ENTRIES:

An entry may not contain, as determined by the Outcomes Assessment office, in its sole discretion, any content that:

- promotes any particular political candidate, political party, or political viewpoint;
- is sexually explicit or suggestive; violent or derogatory of any ethnic, racial, gender, religious, professional or age group; profane or pornographic;
- promotes alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco, firearms/weapons (or the use of any of the foregoing);
- promotes any activities that may appear unsafe or dangerous;
- is obscene or offensive; endorses any form of hate or hate group;
- defames, misrepresents or contains disparaging remarks about other people or companies;
- contains trademarks, logos or trade dress owned by others;
- contains any person or any personal identification such as personal names or email addresses;
- contains copyrighted materials owned by others;
- contains materials embodying the names, likenesses, voices or other indicia identifying any person, including, without limitation, celebrities and/or other public or private figures, living or dead, without their express consent; or
- violates any applicable law.

We reserve the right to reject any entry which we determine does not meet the above criteria or is otherwise offensive or is not in keeping with the spirit of the competition. Entry must be the original work of the entrant; may not have been previously published; may not have won previous awards; and must not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity or other intellectual property or other rights of any person or entity. If the entry contains any material or elements that are not owned by the entrant, and/or which are subject to the rights of third parties, the entrant is responsible for obtaining, prior to submission of the entry, any and all releases and consents necessary to permit the use and exhibition of the entry in the manner set forth in this contest description, including, without limitation, name and likeness

permissions from any person or any third party who is identifiable in an entry. We reserve the right to request proof of these permissions in a form acceptable to us from any entrant at any time. Failure to provide such proof may, if requested, render entry null and void. By submitting an entry, entrant warrants and represents that they and the person or third party who is identifiable in the entry consent to the submission and use of the entry in the contest and to its use as otherwise set forth herein.
