Steps to Student Dual Credit Enrollment at SWIC

- 1. Submit a New Student Information Form (SWIC application) if you have not done so for a previous dual credit class.
- 2. Set up your eSTORM and SWIC email accounts.
- 3. Meet prerequisites, if necessary: (one or more of these options)
 - a. Ensure that you meet prerequisites for course by one of the following measures: high school GPA (after six semesters), SAT score, or ACT score
 - Schedule placement testing—either at your school site or at a SWIC Testing Center
- 4. Register for classes with SWIC representative (visits scheduled with school administration).
- 5. Check with your instructor to ensure you are on the official SWIC roster.
- 6. Pick up your SWIC ID and Metrolink pass from any SWIC campus.

Tips for a Successful Start at SWIC

- You are a college student- Ensure that you are following all guidelines and meeting the academic requirements of your course(s).
- Meet all deadlines and requisites in order to ensure that you are registered for your class.
- Check your eSTORM student center- Access your schedule and other important information.
- Use your resources, including the Disability and Access Center, Success Center, Library, and Career Services.
